

Nilotic Meridian 31°14'East

The Nilotic Meridian is an earth ley line that runs through Africa roughly along 31°14'E longitude.

It is a very wide meridian, and is at the geographic center of the earth's land masses.

North of the equator it runs along the course of the river Nile, the only river on earth to run from south to north.

South of the equator it runs along the "river of gold", tracing sites where gold has been mined over centuries.



Many significant Sacred Sites are found all along the Nilotic Meridian, including the Giza plateau, the Temple of Philae, Great Zimbabwe and Timbavati, birthplace of the sacred White Lions.



In esoteric terms, the Nilotic Meridian is a sacred subterranean river, a vibration or a living energy, kept alive by all the sacred sites along it and ceremonies that are continuously performed at these sites.

Reflected in the heavens is a "river of stars", the Milky Way.

Zep Tepi “First Time”

Sacred Sites along the Nilotic Meridian

- 30°N - The Sphinx and Pyramids of Giza
- 26°N - Luxor Temple, Karnak Temple, Valley of the Kings & Queens
Temples in Abydos & Dendera
- 24°N - The Temple of Philae, dedicated to the Goddess Isis
- 0° - The Equator, and source of the river Nile
- 20°S - Great Zimbabwe
- 24°S - Timbavati, birthplace of the sacred White Lions
- 25°S - Blyde River Canyon
- 26°S - gold mining town of Barberton
- 30°S - Phoenix settlement established by Mahatma Gandhi
