

# BEING A WHOLE HUMAN

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Connecting the dots,  
when it is by design,  
generally reveals a picture.  
This morning I connected dots  
of what has been 'coming in',  
and saw for myself more clearly.

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**It is said, in various ways and by various sources, that all possibilities already exist.** See 'universal wave function', below.

When everything already exists, can a human be a creator, or only a revealer?

**A creator** brings into existence, giving form to the formless.

**A revealer** makes known what already exists, but was hidden.

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I'd say that everything already exists, but as potentiality, the formless - until it is observed.

A creator manifests (makes evident to the senses) potentiality into the world of form.

What is hidden is beyond the veil. What is beyond the veil is that which has not been revealed to the senses. Going within the veil is from the ever-changing to the never-changing. Within the veil is where 'I' dwell in the Divine. As the Christian hymn says, the Lord is within the veil.

*Within the veil,  
I now would come,  
into the holy place  
to look upon Thy face.  
I see such beauty there,  
no other can compare,  
I worship Thee, my Lord,  
within the veil.*

The Lord can be understood here as the deep of consciousness, the underlying foundation and greater self of all that is. Worshipping (magnifying) the Lord within the veil makes all clear. When I create from within the veil, it is not the mental manipulation of magic, but manifestation and miracle in the world. From this place I create only in service to the Source of life, by expressing the free flow of energy that is love for love itself.

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The 'Progress of the Soul' meditation asserts:

*I am the Lord, the deep of consciousness.*

*In human awareness, I am a Present Moment Sphere.*

*I am a conscious creator, giving form to the formless.*

*I create, in service to the Source of life.*

*I serve, by being a free flow of energy, that is, love for love itself.*

It is also said, in various ways, that humankind's great fear is the fear of greatness. So it is understandable if people recoil at saying, 'I am the Lord.'

Certainly in the meditation, there is no hubris inherent in the words, and their intended meaning magnifies the Source, whether one calls that the Void, the Tao, God, or the Big Bang.

There are systems of belief which are very specific about planes of existence, and give precise definitions regarding the vast inner realm. Since it still remains an unknown, a belief, it seems such teachings have little value other than as mental masturbation, or for ego inflation. What is their practical application? How do they bring improvement to the believer? It feels to me essential to not get lost in the maze of beliefs, where they become too specific. All I need to know is what works for me.

The 'I am' of the meditation is not the mentally constructed identity of self, but the well of being from which all existence flows. A physicist (and others) may argue with this, and that is okay. I am simply expressing what I feel, that is, my truth in this

moment, and do not claim it to be 'The Truth.' I am presently convinced there is no fixed, absolute Truth outside the never changing, non-specific, Void of pure potentiality. There are measurable laws and forces, but something tells me they are real and not actual.

Blavatsky's definition of Higher Self (below) is not how I mean 'I am the Lord', either. Her definition, according to Wikipedia, says that 'Each and every individual has a Higher self.' The deep of consciousness is the Highest Self of everything. In other words, we are all the Lord, when we dwell within the veil.

The Divine cannot be experienced over the senses or the intellect. Certainly, a person may have physical sensations from an encounter with the Divine, such as goosebumps. Clearly, the Divine is the subject of long philosophical discussions and theological debates. But those are not the same as an experience of the Divine, which is felt over the heart. What prevents people from having a deeply felt, actual experience of union with the Divine, their greater Self? A stubborn hindrance is the fear of one's own greatness.

A Wikipedia article says, 'The Jonah complex is the fear of success or the fear of being one's best which prevents self-actualization, or the realization of one's own potential. It is the fear of one's own greatness, the evasion of one's destiny, or the avoidance of exercising one's talents.'

### **Our Deepest Fear**

Here, 'You are a child of God' could keep a person small, if their acting identity is a child of something outside themselves and it never grows to adulthood. Gary, the self identity (ego-mind) of the human in this lifetime, is a child of the True Self, the Lord I am, the deep of consciousness. That child is intended by intelligent design to grow into an adult identity.

'Our Deepest Fear' says, 'You are a child of God' and the '[Progress of the Soul](#)' meditation affirms, 'I am the Lord, the deep of consciousness.' The latter is not the same as saying 'I am God,' which according to story is the claim used to nail Jesus to the cross.

Neither am I fond of being associated with pantheism,

or with any known doctrine, dogma or ism. However, that may be inevitable, as superficially there seem to be similarities: 'Pantheism is the belief that reality is identical with divinity, or that all-things compose an all-encompassing, immanent god.' I make a distinction between reality and actuality, and do not say that reality is identical with divinity. Our reality is ever-changing, while actuality, the divine, is never-changing. They are not identical but could be called two sides of the same coin.

How does one go within the veil in the sense described here? For me, the way is through the '[Progress of the Soul](#)' meditation, which begins:

*I am the Lord, the deep of consciousness.*

*In human awareness, I am a Present Moment Sphere.*

*I am a conscious creator, giving form to the formless.*

*I create, in service to the Source of life.*

*I serve, by being a free flow of energy, that is, love for love itself.*

The deeper meaning is revealed by sinking into these two versions of scripture:

### **Literal meaning of Jehovah**

'Jehovah is translated as **“The Existing One”** or

**“Lord.”** The chief meaning of Jehovah is derived from

the Hebrew word Havah meaning “to be” or “to exist.” It also suggests “to become” or specifically “to become known” – this denotes a God who reveals Himself unceasingly.' - [Blue Letter Bible](#)

'**Jehovah** is a Latinization of the Hebrew יהוה, one vocalization of the Tetragrammaton יהוה, the proper name of the God of Israel in the Hebrew Bible and one of the seven names of God in Judaism.'

'The **Tetragrammaton** or Tetragram is the four-letter Hebrew word יהוה, the name of the biblical God of Israel. The four letters, read from right to left, are yodh, he, waw and he. While there is no consensus about the structure and etymology of the name, 'the form Yahweh is now accepted almost universally.'

### **Literal meaning of Christ**

...the word “Christ” comes from christos, a Greek word meaning “anointed.” It is the equivalent of the word mashiach, or Messiah, in Hebrew. So, to be the Christ, or Messiah, is to be “the anointed one of God.” - [Our Rabbi Jesus](#)

### **Oneself anointed by One Self**

In 'Progress of the Soul', the meditator is anointed with the elixir of the Third Eye:

'Inhale Present Moment Light into your pineal gland, feeling it open the Eye of Ra, and focus on the energies of unconditional love, the Christos. Exhale from the Eye of Ra, into the elixir field in the center of the brain, radiating the Christos energies out, feeling the light penetrating the brain. Inhale deeply, pulling Christos energies through the Eye of Ra, down your



energy column and into the sphere around your heart.'

'**Sahasrara** or **Sahastrara** (Sanskrit: सहस्रार, IAST: Sahasrāra, English: "thousand-petaled") or **crown chakra** is generally considered the seventh primary **chakra**, according to most tantric yoga traditions.'
